Pistol scrutineering 7.30am Briefing 8.30am Competition starts 9.00 am

Class 1, 2 and 3 pistols. Competitors may shoot up to two classes per match only.

Event 1 Match 1 - 3P Core Pistol event (25m,15m, 7m) Class 1, 2 & 3 Graded & Junior

Event 2 Match 9 - 50m Long Range Deliberate Class 1, 2 & 3 Open/ Junior

Event 3 Match 6 - Standing Rapid Fire 15m Class 1, 2 & 3 Open & Junior

Event 4 Chairman's Challenge - Match 2 Three position Deliberate 15m and Practice 5&6 From Match 1 Agg scores, Pre-46 Class 1 genuine unmodified "as issued" Open

Top Gun (Class 1 only) consists of Events 1, 2 and 3. Same for team events.

Junior medals in all pistol events are awarded on the top score from either Class 1, 2 or 3.

Tactical rifle matches will be conducted at Canberra Rifle Club and the trainer rifle match run concurrently at SSAA Majura Range. Rifle scrutineering 7.30 am **Tactical and Trainer** Briefing 8.30 am Competition 9.00 am

Event 6 Match 15 - Long range event 500m F1, F2 and T/J Open each class

Event 6 Match 15 - Long range event 300m F1, 400m F2 and 500m T/J all shot on mini-core targets. Open each class.

Event 7 Local Match – "Agony Snap" 500m Class T/J

Ammunition: 10 Rounds.

Targets: 1 x Mini Core Targets (see Annex 5B – Target 6),

Position: Prone supported.

Timing: 10 x 3 second exposures within a maximum of 10 minutes.

Procedure: From the Prone Supported position the competitor engages the target with a single shot in a three second exposure. There are to be 10 single shot exposures, each of three seconds duration within the 10 minute duration of the event. The intervals between exposures are random but a minimum of 5 seconds and the last exposure must commence at least nine minutes and thirty seconds after the start of the first exposure.

Scoring: 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 points per hit.

Note: Shots fired outside the exposures incur a 10 point penalty per shot.

Event 8 Match 20 - Core event .22 Trainer Rifles (Graded & Junior)

Lunch and day 3 presentations to follow.

Directions

The SSAA Majura Range is located in Hector McIntosh Grove which runs off Majura Parkway, entry about one km South of Federal Highway.

Camping

Camping is available on site with shower and toilet facilities and there is a facilities levy of \$10 per adult per night to cover costs.
