Reference Requirements

As part of your application you are required to provide two (2) character references. This is a requirement of the Weapons Act (Part 4, Division 4, Section 98B). A extract from the Weapons Act relating to membership of Approved Pistol Clubs ca be found below on this document.

The information we require in your references is as follows

- The persons providing you the references must have known you for at least two (2) years.
- References will be deemed unacceptable and rejected if the reference is from a relative of the applicant, or living at the same address as the applicant.
- The persons offering you the references must be aged over 18 years, of good standing, and held in high repute in the community.
- The persons providing you the references must mention that they are aware recommend you to join the Pistol Sub-Branch of SSAA Fraser Coast Branch Inc.
- The persons providing the references must supply both their own and the applicants full name, address, phone numbers, and email address.
- The references must be addressed by the providers to The Secretary, SSAA Fraser Coast Branch Inc.

Statement of Eligiblity

- If you do not have an existing Weapons/Firearms Licence, you will need to attend a police station, fill in and lodge a QP0515 - Application for Statement of Eligibility to Join an Approved Pistol Shooting Club. There is no fee required for this. You may need to provide a copy of your two character references.
- Once you have received the Statement of Eligibility from QPS then you will need to provide a copy of this to the Branch with your application.
- If you have an existing Weapons/Firearms Licence, then yo do not need to obtain a Statement of Eligibility.

Administration Fee

• The administration fee fulfills the requirement by Weapons Licensing Branch to be a financial member of an approved club. The administration fee is not refundable if the application is unsuccessful.

Please Note

Extract from Weapons Act 1990 Part 4, Division 4, Section 98B

Membership of approved pistol clubs

- (1) It is a condition of an approved pistol club's shooting club permit that the club must not accept a person for membership of the club unless the person submits with the person's application for membership—
 - (a) if the person is not a licensee, a current statement in the approved form signed by an authorised officer that the person is a fit and proper person to hold a licence; and
 - (b) 2 character references from persons the person has known for at least 2 years; and
 - (c) a declaration that the person is a current member of other named approved shooting clubs or that the person is not a current member of any other approved shooting club.
- (2) A statement mentioned in subsection (1)(a) is current for 3 months after the day it is signed by the authorised officer.
